Ellen holds a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology from Holy Family University, a Master of Education in Elementary Education/Multicultural Education from Eastern University (4.0 GPA), and a Master of Education in Educational Leadership from Lehigh University (4.0 GPA). She holds Pennsylvania certifications in Educational Leadership: Administration and Supervision Principal K–12, and Elementary Education. Ellen began her career as a classroom teacher at St. William School in Philadelphia, where she served for nearly a decade before transitioning into literacy coaching and instructional leadership. As a Literacy Coach and Grade Teacher at Elkin and Southwark Schools, she provided professional development to 50+ teachers, implemented guided reading groups, and supported English language learners through targeted vocabulary and comprehension strategies. Her early work established a deep commitment to data-driven instruction and equitable access to literacy that has defined her career.

As a School Based Instructional Specialist and Reading First Coach at Bayard Taylor School, Ellen managed a \$100,000 annual budget, provided professional development to 40+ teachers and leadership team members, and achieved 60% growth in reading levels among 300+ students in grades K–3. She served as a City Year Greater Philadelphia Liaison and contributed to curriculum development and assessment for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

At Pan American Academy Charter School, Ellen served as Master Teacher Coach, utilizing data-driven instruction that produced 50% gains in reading achievement levels in grades 4 through 8. She conducted formal and informal teacher evaluations, facilitated professional learning communities, and led the New Teacher Induction Program. As District Coach for ASPIRA Inc. of Pennsylvania Charter Schools, she streamlined communication and improved instructional outcomes across five schools — including a high school, two elementary schools, a middle school, and a cyber school — serving 200+ educators and reducing teacher turnover through sustained mentorship and professional support.

At Olney Charter High School ASPIRA Inc. of PA, Ellen served as Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assistant Principal, where she increased the graduation rate by 95% over a two-and-a-half year timeframe, managed \$1.5 million annual budgets, integrated technology into 100+ classrooms, and trained 20+ leadership team members on instructional strategies — improving inter-rater reliability from 40% to 95%. She designed intervention programs targeting 3,000+ students and collaborated with assistant superintendents and 50+ subject matter experts to continually improve learning outcomes. She is the recipient of the Best of City Year National Award for Outstanding Literacy Initiative and the City Year Greater Philadelphia Moccasin Award.

Ellen served as a School Improvement Specialist with the Pennsylvania Department of Education, working across Philadelphia and Harrisburg to analyze student achievement data with 10 school leadership teams, lead focus groups with students, parents, and teachers, and develop strategic plans aligned with district-wide objectives. She served as Principal at

CB Community Schools in Philadelphia, where she continues to advance student-centered learning, instructional excellence, and school improvement practices.
